



Amount:
Two new \$500 scholarship will be awarded. This scholarship is eligible for an annual renewal for up to three years.

Criteria:

- Applicant must be a high school senior qualifying for graduation from a Kansas high school.
- Applicants must attend either KSU or KU.
- Applicants must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA.
- Applicants must have participated with success in extra-curricular school activities (e.g., forensics, music, athletics, etc.).
- All merit criteria being the same, awards will be based on need.

Renewal Criteria:
Scholarship recipients are eligible to apply for renewal by meeting the following criteria:


- Recipient must attend either KSU or KU
- Recipient must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA.
- Recipient must provide evidence of continuing financial need.
- Recipient must be continually enrolled as a full-time student.
- Recipient must be making reasonable progress toward an undergraduate degree, regardless of course study.
- Recipients may receive this scholarship for up to 4 years total.

MURPHY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Amount:
The number and amount of awards will vary.

Criteria:


- Applicants should be in good standing qualifying for graduation from an area served by the following school districts: USD 299, 392, 399, 407 and 432. (Applicants may apply from either public or private schools).
- Applicants must display a strong sense of community involvement and leadership.
- Applicant must submit an essay (100 words or less) that outlines his/her major accomplishments, and a challenging experience and how it affected him/her.
- Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation-one from a high school faculty member and one from a community leader. Each recommendation will address the following questions:
 - What is your relationship with the applicant?
 - What do you consider to be the applicant's strengths?
 - What do you consider to be the applicant's weaknesses?
 - Does the applicant exhibit leadership skills? Please explain.
 - Is there any other information the scholarship committee should know about the applicant?
- **Previous scholarship recipients** may apply for renewal as part of the total applicant pool by meeting the following requirements:
 - Recipients must continue to show a strong sense of community involvement and leadership.
 - Applicants must maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.

The number and amount of awards vary. The total amount available is \$2,555.

Criteria:

- Applicants currently are or have been employed by the Salina Country Club within the 24 previous months.
- Applicants must be eligible to attend or are currently attending any accredited post-secondary school.
- Applicants must have a 2.0 minimum GPA.
- Applicants must provide a letter of recommendation from a current or former teacher, or another adult for whom the applicant has studied or worked- outside of the Salina Country Club.
- Applicant should display strong characteristics in one or more areas including: leadership, community service, extra-curricular school activities or employment.
- All merit criteria being the same, the primary basis for awarding scholarships will be student financial need.
- All applicants shall be judged on the merit of the application with regard to the criteria outlined above, and no special preference shall be given to applicants because they may be members of the Salina Country Club.
